Welcome to the Pacific Coast Spring Soccer League. This is our twelve-year and we are looking forward to another successful season. Please read the following information carefully and return the requested forms along with your check for \$150.00. **The fee will be \$250.00 if received by the registrar after 10:00 PM on 1/25/09.** Forms not completed properly will not be processed and will be returned to you.

When:	All games will be played on Sunday. Games will begin on March 1, 2009 and will continue through May 03, 2009. Each division will play eight games. There will be no playoffs. All games must be completed by May 17, 2009, if the weather requires.
Who:	All AYSO and CYSA class 3 and 4 teams are invited to participate. All players must play at least half the game. <i>CYSA teams may register through our PSSSL AYSO North and South registrar or your home city AYSO registrar.</i>
Age Groups	Boys U10, U12, U14, U16, U19 Girls U10, U12, U14, U16, U19. Note: U10 Standings will be kept for the viewing of the PCSSL Board Members only, as this is a non-competitive age group.
Roster Sizes & # of players on the play field:	U10 B & G - 7 v 7 (12 players on the roster) U12 B & G - 9 v 9 (14 players on the roster) U14 B & G - U19 B & G - 11 V 11 (18 players on the roster)
Coaches:	All coaches must meet the following requirements: AYSO U10: U10 Coach License , U12: U12 Coach License , U14-U19: At least a U12 Coach License . CYSA: Coach-E/D license, Assist. Coach-F license. If it is a CYSA coaches first year coaching they should presently be holding an F license. All coaches must be certified, (AYSO Safe Haven) All coaches will be required to attend the mandatory coaches/referee meeting, <u>Tuesday, 2/24/09, 7:00 PM at JLS Middle School, 480 E. Meadow, Palo Alto</u> A (1) one-point deduction in standings will occur for non-attendance of any mandatory meetings.
Fields:	Fields, nets and corner flags are the responsibility of the home team. Each team should secure a field for home games.
Referees:	Referees will be required to attend the coaches/referee meeting, <u>Tuesday, 2/24/09, 7:00 PM at JLS Middle School, 480 E. Meadow, Palo Alto</u> Referees will be of the highest caliber. Minimum requirement – AYSO Regional Badge/USSF Referee Grade 8. Procurement of referees is the responsibility of the home team. <u>All matches must have one referee and two assistant referees</u>
Fees:	\$150.00 (\$250.00 if received by the registrar after 10 :00 PM on 1/25/09.) Checks should be made out to PCSSL.
Scores & Standings:	All scores must be reported within 24 hours on <u>www.mysoccerleague.com</u> .
Requirements:	All players and coaches will require a laminated player pass that includes a photo of the player/coach and medical release forms. AYSO/CYSA teams may obtain player passes from their regions registrar or their designated PCSSL/AYSO registrar contact. Completed passes must be submitted no later than ten days prior to the mandatory coaches/referee meeting.
Registration:	All teams must submit a completed field/referee schedule. AYSO teams and CYSA teams must submit a team roster signed by their regional commissioner or PCSSL AYSO North or South Registrar. <u>The registration packet will not be accepted without one of these signatures.</u> CYSA players must submit an AYSO registration form for each player to their designated PCSSL AYSO registrar contact. Return the above completed information and your check made out to PCSSL for 150.00 to the league registrar no later than <u>Sunday, January 25, 2009, \$250.00 if received by the PCSSL registrar after 10:00 PM</u>

1.0 Membership

1.01 The PCSSL Spring Playing League is a developmental league promoting interplay and cooperation between members of AYSO and CYSA. All league members will be developmental teams, which are properly registered with AYSO. League members must submit by the published deadline an entry form and a copy of their approved roster.

1.02 Members must submit the league entry fee with a check made payable to PCSSL League by the published deadline.

1.03 Players are not allowed to play both on an AYSO and a CYSA team in the league.

1.04 Addition to rosters will be accepted through the third league game played by the team.

2.0 Playing Rules

2.01 Playing format:

U10	7 a side	2 - 25 Minute halves	5 min half-time break	#4 Ball
U12	9 a side	2 - 30 Minute halves	5 min half-time break	#4 Ball
U14	11 a side	2 - 35 Minute halves	5 min half-time break	#5 Ball
U16	11 a side	2 - 45 Minute halves	5 min half-time break	#5 Ball
U19	11 a side	2 - 45 Minute halves	5 min half-time break	#5 Ball

2.02 Three (3) points will be awarded for a win, one (1) point for a tie, and zero (0) points for a loss. There will be no overtime for league games. U10's standings will be kept for the viewing of the PCSSL board members only, as this is a non-competitive age group.

2.03 There will be a (1) point deduction for each red card issued a player

2.04 Games will start on schedule. Unless there is a delay by a previous game, a team that has not taken the field within 15 minutes of the scheduled start of a game will forfeit the match. A U10 team must have at least (5) players, U12 (6) players, and U14 - U19 (7) players to take the field or the team will forfeit the game

2.05 A forfeit winner is awarded three (3) points and loser zero (0) points. If both teams forfeit the game, each team is awarded a loss and zero points.

2.06 Substitution: Every player present at the time of game kickoff will be expected to play a minimum of one half of the game

For U10 through U12, a "substitution break" midway through each half will occur. No free substitution is allowed for these ages.

For U14 and U19, free substitutions are permitted throughout the game using the following procedures:

- Coach calls to the Center Ref. for substitution at his team's throw-in, any goal kick or any kick-off, AND
- The substitute(s) are standing at the halfway line ready to enter with the referees' permission.
- If the players are not ready, then the referee may not acknowledge the substitution request.

2.07 The team listed first on the schedule is the home team and any conflict of colors will be resolved by having the home team change colors for the game.

2.08 Coaches are expected to discourage running of excessive scores, defined as a 5-goal differential.

2.09 Coaches will report scores on [mysoccerleague.com](http://www.mysoccerleague.com) no later than the day after the match

Cumulative points will identify first and second place teams in each bracket at the end of the season. There will be no playoffs. In the event of a tie in points, the following tiebreaker in sequence will determine the winner:

1. Head to head winner
2. Least goals allowed
3. Coin toss

3.0 Team Conduct

3.01 Coaches are responsible to ensure that their players, parents and fans behave in a respectful manner.

3.02 Teams (players, credentialed coaches with current season pass) will occupy one side of the field during the entire game and will not be allowed behind the goal line or within one yard of the touchline.

All spectators must be on the opposite side.

3.03 The referee at his/her discretion may abandon a game under the following conditions:

1. A team leaves the field during play without the approval of the referee.
2. A team is sent from the field by the referee for frequent and/or violent misconduct
3. Extreme "side line area" misconduct (by player, coach, or fans) that causes interruption of play.

3.04 Points for abandonment forfeitures: forfeit winner – 3 points; forfeit loser – zero (0) points

3.05 Additional disciplinary penalties may be imposed at the discretion of the League Commissioners.

4.0 Referees

4.01 *The home team is responsible for providing a center referee and two assistant referees for each game. Referees must have proper credentials. Lack of proper referees is basis for protesting a game.*

4.02 A properly completed game card must be submitted to the proper authority for a game to be officially recognized. A properly completed game card must also be submitted in the event of a forfeited or abandoned game.

4.03 Both teams must complete the game card before the start of the game and give it to the referee. The game card must be legible and contain the name of each team player participating and their corresponding jersey number.

4.04 A properly approved Player/Coach Pass must be presented to the referee for each player/coach who participated in the game. ***The PCSSL sticker must be laminated in the card. No Pass, No Play!*** The referee will verify the identify of the player/coach by his pass, and the referee during the game will retain the passes,

4.05 The referee will check player uniform and equipment before the start of the game.

4.06 The referee will monitor and keep written record of substitutions on the game card for U10 – U12, but not for U14 – U19.

4.07 Upon completion of the game, the referee must sign the game cards and mail them in the envelope provided by the home team coach, to **STEVEN KUHNER** within 24 hours of the game date. Any player pass of any ejected player and a properly completed referee report are to be mailed to **HOWARD MILLER**.

4.08 Referee judgment calls are final and not to be protested.

5.0 Cautions and Dismissals

5.01 A player who receives a red card must leave the field of play immediately. An ejected player will serve a minimum one game suspension, which will begin on the next regularly scheduled game.

5.02 A player who receives a second red card in a season will be dismissed from the league.

6.0 Coaching

6.01 A team coach with a proper coach pass must be present for a team to take the field of play.

6.02 Coaching will be confined to the sideline within ten yards of midfield.

6.03 Coaching directives from the sideline should be positive and encouraging.

6.04 The medical release form for each player must be in the coach's possession at all games.

6.05 Any games played with ineligible players will be forfeited

6.06 All coaches and assistant coaches must turn in an AYSO volunteer form: this can be done online, AYSO Coach and Assistant Coach Safe Haven Mandatory.

7.0 Scheduling

7.01 The playing league schedule will take preference over any conflicts and games will not be rescheduled, except by league officials.

7.02 The home team is responsible for providing a suitable field for each game. An insurance certification for all fields must be obtained from the teams parent soccer association.

7.03 Regular league games will be scheduled on Sunday's. The coach of the home team must call and confirm the scheduled game with the visiting coach at least 72 hours prior to each game.

7.04 Cancellation of games due to inclement weather will be communicated by coaches to the league website administrator. Falsification of information will be grounds for forfeiture.

7.05 In the event of any game cancellation, the home team field administrator with mutual agreement of the coaches will reschedule makeup games. In the event that coaches cannot mutually agree on a make-up date within a responsible time, the team field administrator will reschedule the game at his/her prerogative. A team that cannot field a proper team (see 2:04) for a scheduled makeup game will forfeit the game. If both teams fail to play a rescheduled makeup game, both teams will forfeit. All makeup games should be completed one week prior to the last regularly scheduled league game and should be completed in the order of cancellation.

8.0 Awards

8.01 *First place teams in the U12 – U19 divisions will be awarded individual medals and t-shirts. Second place teams in the U12 – U19 divisions will be awarded individual medals.*

8.02 All participating players and coaches will receive a league souvenir.

8.03 All U10 players will receive a participation medal.

9.0 Disciplinary Rulings

9.01 The League Disciplinary Coordinator will determine disciplinary action according to the disciplinary rules of their respective association. The League Disciplinary Coordinator will deal with all protests and appeals. Any protest or appeal shall be made in writing and accompanied by a non-refundable \$50.00 check (check payable to PCSSL). Such protests and appeals will be postmarked within seventy-two (72) hours of the competition or action being protested. Protests should be mailed to the PCSSL League Director:

10.0 The league director will resolve situations not covered by these rules.
